## LANDSCAPE WORKSHEET



Use the grid below to see which coastal landscape designs will best fit on your property. Follow these steps:

- Measure your property boundaries and outline them on the grid. Use a drawing scale appropriate for your lot, for example 1 square equals 5 feet. The worksheet is 30-squares-by-30-squares.
  Measure and outline buildings, driveways, impervious surfaces (e.g. paving or patios). Refer to a deed map, if
- one is available, for building dimensions.
- Measure and draw existing trees, shrubs, perennials, vegetable gardens and other features you want to retain.
  Make several copies of your drawing to use for preparing your final plan.
- 5. Sketch in locations and configurations of new landscaping. Be sure you know the sun and soil conditions on your property before choosing designs and plants to use.
